AFTER SCHOOL CLUB DESCRIPTIONS

SPORTS with Coach Amanda - This is a fun, active program geared towards working on total body movement, enhancing hand eye coordination, improving over all body control, and giving children the tools they need for a healthy active lifestyle. Our overall goals for each child is to make them feel successful, accomplished, and confident all while learning new physical, and social skills. We exist to build strength, confidence, and character.

CRAFTY KIDS - Let your children grow their creative and social confidence through process art, hands on DIY crafts and sensory play.

COOKING

Cooking with children is an ideal way to teach principles of good nutrition and encourage lifelong healthy eating habits. Children are more likely to try new foods when they have a hand in preparing them. Children that are exposed to new ingredients are expanding their stock of acceptable foods, setting them on a path to be "good eaters" for life. Cooking gives preschoolers an early grounding in science, math, language, art and even reading? The kitchen offers abundant lessons in basic chemistry- discovering how certain ingredients combine, react, and change as they cook. When the students describe what they are see, taste and feel, they are feeding their vocabulary. Exposing kids to food's myriad colors and textures provides them with a whole new creative palette - and palate. Plus, reading through a recipe helps children learn how to follow words from left to right, while beginning to distinguish numbers from letters. Fine motor skills are also enhanced when little fingers tear, stir and pour.

"Sensei Josh" has spent his career focused on programs for children, from the martial arts to Save the Children.

The program will provide our children additional opportunities to learn through play and exercise, while further developing their focus, self control, teamwork and listening skills. All while learning more about some of their favorite animals such as Tigers, Leopards, Dragons, Snakes and Cranes!

Every Thursday, Sensei Josh will help our children further develop their motor skills and coordination through kung fu, while also discussing the importance of principles such as Respect, Self-Control, Self-Discipline, Honesty and Patience.

Brooklyn Robot Foundry - We spark curiosity and creativity in our youngest learners by blending hands-on fun with the magic of storytelling! With a little help from grown-ups, these tiny makers dive into STEAM adventures where they get to build, tinker, and explore all on their own. The best part? They'll walk away beaming with pride, excited to play with their awesome creations —and keep the learning going long after class is over!
